If you desire to vote YES or NO for a PROPOSED QUESTION, blacken the corresponding Oval (●). Use only pen or pencil. If you spoil your ballot, do not erase, but ask for a new ballot.

Understand that the offering or acceptance of money or any other thing of value for any particular candidate, post, or candidate, issue, or set of issues prohibited by this law, constitutes an illegal bribe, and is a felony under Georgia law (OCGA §§ 7-2-2(b)(4) and 21-2-2(b)(1)).
